Criteria

Applicants must be full-time non-final year undergraduate students of The Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Application and selection procedures

- 1. Applicants should complete and submit the online application form.
- 2. Applicants will be shortlisted for interview and personality inventory. The interview will be conducted from October 14 November 1, 2024. The selection result will be released by November 8, 2024.
- 3. Successful candidates are required to pay a deposit of HK\$500. Deposits will be refunded upon the completion of the training (over 80% attendance of training) and the service projects.

1. Attend all training sessions, adventure camp, practicum and supervision, and workshops. (All training will be mainly conducted **in Cantonese**)
