2. Can I join uBuddies, uPals and uShine Programme at the same time?

Although the application form for the uBuddies, uPals and uShine Programme is the same, you can only join only **ONE** during the same school year. You are required to indicate your first two preferences on the application form.

3. What is the application procedure?

First, you should submit the online application form before the deadline. Within 2 weeks after the application deadline, shortlisted applicants will receive an email invitation for an interview.

4. What if I couldn't attend some of the training workshops?

Please note that successful candidates must attend at least 80% attendance of all training programme and complete service projects in order to retrieve their deposit and obtain certificate. For Mental Health First Aid Standard Course, you have to complete the full 12-hours training for the MHFA certificate.
